Reporting to the Managers of Operations, the Apprentice Lineperson is responsible for construction and maintenance of overhead and underground distribution systems. Duties include but are not limited to maintaining tools and equipment, troubleshooting repairs and restoration of system outages.

Applicants must be enrolled in and have completed Level 1 or Level 2 of a Powerline Technician program in a community college program. Applicants must be enrolled with the Ministry of Training colleges and universities as a registered Powerline Apprentice. Applicants must possess knowledge of the Occupational Health & Safety Act and the EUSA Rule Book. The applicant must be First Aid, CPR and AED certified. Knowledge of WHIMIS, Book 7 Traffic Control, fall arrest and chainsaw training are required. Applicants must possess a valid G or DZ (preferably) Ontario Driver's License in good standing.
