Brantford Power bills to be reduced 10%

BRANTFORD ON – Brantford Power's residential and small commercial customers have begun to enjoy a 10-per-cent reduction in their monthly bills thanks to the Ontario Clean Energy Benefit (OCEB). The benefit is designed to help offset the costs of upgrading and modernizing Ontario's energy infrastructure under Ontario's Long-Term Energy Plan.

Customers will begin to see the reductions on their bills effective January 21, 2011. Implementation will be pro-rated so that customers will see the OCEB only on consumption as of January 1, 2011. For example, the first bills to be issued this month were read on January 4 so the reduction will be based on the customer's consumption during the first three days of the month up to January 4.

Ontario's Long-Term Energy Plan is designed to move the province to clean sources of power while shutting down coal plants that pollute the air. Building more clean energy is also creating thousands of jobs for Ontarians in growing renewable energy industries like solar, wind and hydroelectric.

The 10-per-cent reduction, which is applied to the electricity delivery charges, regulatory charges, the debt retirement charge, cost of electricity and taxes, will be applied to Brantford Power bills for the next five years.
