



Self-Declaration Form Debt Retirement Charge (DRC) Exemption

Effective January 1, 2016, non-residential general service-rate class customers where electricity is provided to one or more “eligible residential units” are eligible for a Debt Retirement Charge exemption of up to 1,500 kilowatt hours (kWh) per month multiplied by the number of eligible residential units as described below.

An “eligible residential unit” is a unit that:

- (a) is a self-contained set of rooms located in a building or structure,
- (b) contains kitchen and bathroom facilities that are intended for the use of that unit only, and
- (c) is used or intended for use as a residential premise.

Note: to qualify, the unit must meet all three of the criteria included above.

Customers must self-declare their eligibility for the Debt Retirement Charge Exemption if they qualify. Please return this completed form by December 31, 2015 to register your account so that you may receive the DRC exemption beginning January 2016. If your form is received after your January bill has already been issued, the exemption will be reflected on a subsequent month’s bill. The exemption is not available for billing periods before the billing period in which the notice is received.
